There's also a weekly Monday Printing Club, a shorter, cheaper and more informal session that looks at a different printing technique each week.




PRINT WORKERS BARCELONA, AN INSTITUTE THAT BELIEVES IN 'NO PRINT, NO FUN!!!'





- Adhesive/ Non-Adhesive Binding, Etc.





- He is the author of more than 60 books on topics related to the printing industry including most recently his trilogy: -History of the Linotype Company -History of the Photo Type-setting Era and -History of Desktop Publishing
- He founded the publication, TypeWorld, and has been the editor for many editions of an indispensable industry tool: Pocket Pal, The Handy Book of Graphic Arts Production.
- He has reached thousands of people through his consulting, writing, and speeches.
- His students will remember his years as a professor at Rochester Institute of Technology (RIT) and Research Professor from Industry at California Polytechnic State University (Cal Poly).
